Question of the Week for the Transfiguration of Our Lord:

Question for Children: How do you show that you listen to Jesus?

Question for Youth: How does your faith in Jesus as the Son of God affect your life?

Question for Adults: When have you had a “transfiguration” experience? What was it like?

Faith in Action:

Faith in Action was a very eye opening experience about how God works in the homeless community. The second day we went to a food kitchen called the Franciscan kitchen in Louisville. My job at the food kitchen was handing out drinks and filling drinks. But that's not where I saw God. I saw him in every person that walked through that had a plastic rosary, which was about a quarter of the people to half of them that walked in with rosaries. Second, I saw God when Friar Andrew would stop everyone from eating every 15 minutes or so to say an Our Father and when I looked around I saw almost everyone was saying the prayer along with Friar Andrew. Third, I saw God when we got to sit and eat with the people. I got to know one person really well. He said he bounced back and forth from Atlanta and Louisville depending on family and that he was currently homeless. But the thing I found crazy was even though he was homeless he told me he still attends Mass every Sunday. Also, not only did I see God throughout the week but I learned a lot about myself and I learned a lot about the catholic faith by getting to meet some of the Friars and getting to know a Friar (because he was my group leader) and getting to learn from him about the catholic faith. I learned a lot about myself because I learned that I do want to do something in the church at some point in my life such as becoming a priest. The reason I learned this is because for the second time on a retreat I saw that someone struggling in life and I took them aside and just sat there and prayed with them. I learned on this retreat that I enjoy helping people find God and helping people get closer to God. All in all Faith in Action is a great retreat and I highly recommend it to the upcoming high schoolers and the current high schoolers who could possibly attend it because I had a lot of fun and it's my favorite retreat I've been in so far. – Blake Barrett

Jeanne called the meeting to order by issuing copies of letters that will be sent to picnic potential businesses and donors requesting their help by purchasing an advertisement banner, donating in general, or donating specifically for the silent auction. She also handed out a list of businesses who purchased banners last year and asked members to suggest new businesses to contact.

Jeanne announced that Earl Book and his Carriage Ford Team graciously will once again provide the picnic with a car to raffle and that Lucille and Vicki Fessel have donated a gorgeous, intricately-made quilt of the in twined pattern to be raffled off.

Those dumplings will be bagged after the 8:00 mass on August 6. Jo added that the second dumpling making session will take place August 12.

Jerry Baker informed the committee that 240 pounds of chicken will be cooked and the broth made on August 5. Help will be needed after a pitch-in breakfast at 8:30 to debone, chop, and bag that chicken.

Committee members chose not to seek co-chairs for themselves, but agreed to keep notes on what their responsibilities are for the picnic and be willing to counsel or advise their successors.

Christy Jones gave an impressive, detailed report on the progress she has made in preparing for the Beer Garden which will take place September 22, the Friday before our picnic which is on September 24. Christy has secured a team of workers, hired a band "Taylor Lynch and the Insane Outlaws," and planned the layout, set-up, and admission price.

The committee decided that a small 7 to 10 item Live Auction will be held right after the Silent Auction closes at 3:00. There will be an announcement in the church bulletin requesting the service of any parishioner who is an auctioneer.

Christy Jones led a closing prayer.

Our next meeting will be held July 27, at 6:30 in the church basement.
