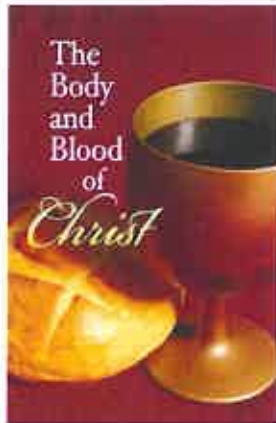

I want to thank each of you for your prayers throughout my formation and discernment. I also want to thank you for the community that you have shared with me. You have all formed me in so many different ways and I thank God for the part you play in my life. Special thanks to Fr. Aaron for his patience with me in asking him so many different questions and for his encouragement. Please continue to remember me and my family in your prayers as I approach ordination and begin this new journey in my life.

Many people have asked me about what a Deacon can do.
